## WHAT IS ACTION INDIA

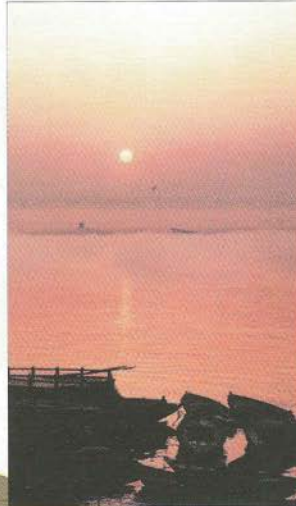

Action India needs committed people who can innovate, communicate and execute these dimensions and processes of development.

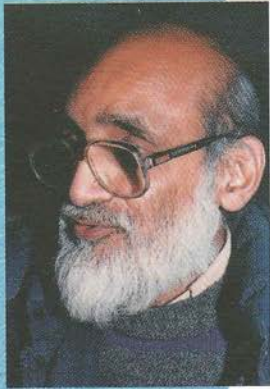
## The agenda for India must focus on the new strategies on various DIMENSIONS OF DEVELOPMENT such as:
